I. Because The Apostles had such rich relationships with Christ and walked in extraordinary grace one of their biggest struggles was to get people to see them as human.

Acts 10:25-27

25 - As Peter entered his home, Cornelius fell at his feet and worshiped him.

26 - But Peter pulled him up and said, “Stand up! I’m a human being just like you!”

27 - So they talked together and went inside, where many others were assembled.

Acts 14:11,14

11 - When the crowd saw what Paul had done, they shouted in their local dialect, “These men are gods in human form!”

12 - They decided that Barnabas was the Greek god Zeus and that Paul was Hermes, since he was the chief speaker.

13 - Now the temple of Zeus was located just outside the town. So the priest of the temple and the crowd brought bulls and wreaths of flowers to the town gates, and they prepared to offer sacrifices to the apostles.

14 - But when the apostles Barnabas and Paul heard what was happening, they tore their clothing in dismay and ran out among the people, shouting,

15 - “Friends, why are you doing this? We are merely human beings—just like you! We have come to bring you the Good News that you should turn from these worthless things and turn to the living God, who made heaven and earth, the sea, and everything in them.

II. One of the main reasons people thought they were extraordinary was how they were victorious under problems which should have made ordinary people lose.

Acts 28:6 (msg)

3-6 Paul pitched in and helped. He had gathered up a bundle of sticks, but when he put it on the fire, a venomous snake, roused from its torpor by the heat, struck his hand and held on. Seeing the snake hanging from Paul's hand like that, the natives jumped to the conclusion that he was a murderer getting his just deserts.

Paul shook the snake off into the fire, none the worse for wear. They kept expecting him to drop dead, but when it was obvious he wasn't going to, they jumped to the conclusion that he was a god!
