I. Why This Message On This Day?

Mathew 13:22

22 - He also that received seed among the thorns is he that heareth the word; and the care of this world, and the deceitfulness of riches, choke the word, and he becometh unfruitful.

Matthew 28:17 (ESV)

17 - And when they saw him they worshiped him, but some doubted.

2 Corinthians 1:3&4 (AMP)

3 - Blessed [gratefully praised and adored] be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of mercies and the God of all comfort,

4 - who comforts *and*
encourages us in every trouble
so that we will be able to comfort
and encourage those who are in
any kind of trouble, with the
comfort with which we ourselves
are comforted by God.

4. When difficulties are approached correctly they produce the US we were always intended to be.

James 1:2-4 (AMP)

2 - Consider it nothing but joy, my brothers and sisters, whenever you fall into various trials.

3 - Be assured that the testing of your faith [through experience] produces endurance [leading to spiritual maturity, and inner peace].

4 - And let endurance have its perfect result *and* do a thorough work, so that you may be perfect and completely developed [in your faith], lacking in nothing.

3. It Is preparation for future leadership

For example, when Joseph served Potiphar, he learned to be a manager; when Joseph was betrayed and abused, he learned firsthand the value of justice and mercy.

1. To change your direction

Proverbs 20:30 (GNT)

**30 - Sometimes it takes a
painful experience to make
us change our ways.**

1 Peter 4:12&13 (MSG)

12-13 Friends, when life gets really difficult, don't jump to the conclusion that God isn't on the job. Instead, be glad that you are in the very thick of what Christ experienced. This is a spiritual refining process, with glory just around the corner.
