

Proverbs 29:18

18 - Where there is no vision, the people are unrestrained, but happy is he who keeps the law

Vision is the bridge between the present and the future. Without it we perish or go “unrestrained.”. Vision gives pain a purpose. Those without vision spend their lives taking the path of least resistance as they try to avoid discomfort. The level of sacrifice that a vision requires will determine the number of people who follow. Sacrifice separates the small from the great.

**1. Writing the vision brings clarity.
Clarity prevents confusion.**

Habakkuk 2:2-3

**Then the LORD answered me and said,
'Write the vision and inscribe it on
tablets, that the one who reads it may
run. For the vision is yet for the
appointed time; it hastens toward the
goal and it will not fail. Though it tarries,
wait for it; for it will certainly come, it will
not delay.'**

3. Vision gives strength when the journey is tough.
