

Kingdom Culture vs. Man's Culture



I. The battle is for control of culture.

Culture — It is the social life of humanity, environment created by human beings in the areas of “language, habits, ideas, beliefs, customs, social organization, historical Interpretations, technical processes, and values.”

Genesis 1:27-28 (AMP)

27 - So God created man in His own image, in the image and likeness of God He created him; male and female He created them.

28 - And God blessed them [granting them certain authority] and said to them, “Be fruitful, multiply, and fill the earth, and subjugate it [putting it under your power]; and rule over (dominate) the fish of the sea, the birds of the air, and every living thing that moves upon the earth. |

2 Corinthians 4:4 (NLT)

4 - Satan, who is the god of this world, has blinded the minds of those who don't believe. They are unable to see the glorious light of the Good News. They don't understand this message about the glory of Christ, who is the exact likeness of God.

II. Satan uses the same methods to steal the morals, thinking and strength of a nation. He desires to own the culture.

Daniel Taken to Babylon

Daniel 1-5 (MSG)

1-2: It was the third year of King Jehoiakim's reign in Judah when King Nebuchadnezzar of Babylon declared war on Jerusalem and besieged the city. The Master handed King Jehoiakim of Judah over to him, along with some of the furnishings from the Temple of God. Nebuchadnezzar took king ...

3-5 The king told Ashpenaz, head of the palace staff, to get some Israelites from the royal family [those who represents family] and nobility [famous people with influence] —young men who were healthy and handsome, intelligent and well-educated, good prospects for leadership positions in the government, perfect specimens [YOUNG PEOPLE WITH SWAG]!—and indoctrinate them in the Babylonian language and the lore of magic and fortunetelling.

III. He set them up to look like no morals, selfish thinking and following your impulses rewards you with the “GOOD LIFE!”

...The king then ordered that they be served from the same menu as the royal table —the best food, the finest wine [expose them to appetites which they wouldn't want to shut down].

After three years of training they would be given positions in the king's court [3 years was the amount of time it took Jesus to train the disciples in the principles of Kingdom].
