


Prepare for the

The creative spirit is certainly favored by God and our fellow man. Learn more from the collection of Bible verses about creativity next..


A fundamental characteristic

The Account of Creation





1 Timothy 4:14

14 Do not neglect your gift, which was given you through prophecy when the body of elders laid their hands on you.

Ephesians 2:10 (CEB)

10 Instead, we are God's accomplishment, created in Christ Jesus to do good things. God planned for these good things to be the way that we live our lives.

The Greek word here is poiéma (pronounced “poy’-ay-mah”), which means “a thing made” or “a work,” and is the object of the verb poieó, which means “to make, do.”

These two linguistic cousins describe the creative act – the one who makes and the thing that is made.

The word only appears in one other place in the Bible, in Romans 1:20, where it refers to the collective works of God in creation, or the sum of all things that God has made, a sort of greatest hits collection of the Creator’s most fantastic works.

9 Steps

1. Pray
2. Place yourself around doers not just talkers
3. Set benchmarks and be disciplined to keep them
4. Take constructive advice, but don't ask for permission.
5. Practice, practice, practice
6. Be willing to Create your own formula. ...
7. Take constructive advice, but don't ask for permission. ...
8. Do the work. ...
9. Celebrate your progress.
